## Disabled Access Requirements

This course has integrated the accessibility requirements for multi-family & non-residential of the 2010 California Building Code, The Americans with Disabilities Act Accessible Guidelines (ADAAG) and the ABA, FHA and Universal Design requirements. The course covers the scoping and technical requirements for Title II and Title III facilities, and the common applications within these facilities and sites. The instructor will work with attendees to clarify all aspects of State and Federal accessibility provisions. Participants of this course will gain a better understanding of California and the Federal Accessibility standards, the differences between them and their applicability. Also covered will be the recent changes to the California and the Federal accessibility requirements.
